

ABOUT THE BOOK

Ebba and Ivar's class has a substitute teacher, Miss Sparre. Everyone in the class thinks that she looks weird. She is very tall and thin and her hands are ice cold. Other strange things are that she cannot stand the sun and that she seems to be able to read people's thoughts. What is she? A vampire? A ghost? Ebba and Ivar must find out.

Do you believe in ghosts?

Do ghosts exist? Some people believe for example that certain houses are haunted. That dead people's souls are in the houses – ghosts. Can that be true? Discuss in class.

Put the phrases in order

Have the students work in groups. For each group, cut out the phrases on the next page (without the numbers), mix them up and ask the groups to put them in order. Then compare in class.

A summary

There are 14 chapters in this book. Have the students work in pairs. Give each pair one or two chapters and ask them to write keywords about the chapter(s). Ask each pair to give an oral summary of their chapter (after practising).
