# INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT OSCAR WILDE

- His full name was Oscar Fingal O'Flahertie Wills Wilde.
- His father, William Wilde, was an acclaimed doctor.
   He founded St. Mark's Ophthalmic Hospital to treat the city's poor.
- His mother, Jane Wilde, was a successful writer.
- An early romantic love of Oscar Wilde was Florence Balcombe: she became the wife of Bram Stoker, the author of Dracula.
- While at Magdalen College, Wilde began wearing his hair long and openly scorning "manly" sports, and began decorating his rooms with peacock feathers, lilies, sunflowers and objets d'art.
